Explanatory Note

The effect of the above proposals would be that the local authority nurture provision at Betws Primary School would close on 1 June 2019.

Welsh Government has approved the introduction of foundation phase at The Bridge Alternative Provision.

The published admission number for Ysgol Gynradd Gymraeg Calon Y Cymoedd is 30. The published admission number for a school is the minimum number of pupils in the "relevant age group" (ie the age group to which children are normally admitted) that the school would be required to admit on demand. More children than this number can be admitted to the school (subject to the provisions of the local authority's admissions policy) if the local authority considers that there is sufficient accommodation available at the particular time, and provided that to do so would not prejudice the efficient use of education resources.
