Sixth-form mergers

Two types of sixth-form merger are under consideration.

- 1. A school could change from one for 11-18 year olds to one just for 11-16 year olds. This means their post-16 students would go to a different school or sixth-form centre. This will be a **statutory** process which means the council will decide which schools, if any, merge. The new sixth form or centre would be managed independently of the 11-16 schools.
- Where schools stay as schools for 11-18 year olds and voluntary merge their sixth forms. These would be jointly managed by the schools that merge. All schools would contribute resources and staff to the new sixth form with common timetables between the schools.

Option 1

Outcome A – Brynteg School becomes a sixth-form centre and hosts sixth-form students from Bryntirion comprehensive

A sixth-form centre would be developed on the Brynteg School campus

Because of the money needed for building this, it may not start being built until 2025

The sixth-form centre could be managed and run by both schools or Bryntirion Comprehensive could become an 11-16 year olds school and the centre run by Brynteg School.

Outcome B - Porthcawl Comprehensive keeps its sixth form

Porthcawl Comprehensive has an established and large sixth form with 242 students. In addition, because of the distance students would have to travel to another school or sixth-form centre it is proposed that Porthcawl Comprehensive keeps its sixth form in place.

Outcome C – Cynffig Comprehensive closes or merges its sixth form with Porthcawl Comprehensive

Cynffig Comprehensive has the smallest sixth form in Bridgend with 61 students. Because of this it is proposed that the sixth form closes, or merges with Porthcawl Comprehensive.

Outcome D – Cynffig Comprehensive hosts sixth-form centre and hosts sixth-form students from Pencoed Comprehensive and Coleg Cymunedol y Dderwen

There is space at Cynffig Comprehensive to accommodate a sixth-form centre. If the centre was developed the sixth forms at Pencoed Comprehensive and Coleg Cymunedol y Dderwen (CCYD) would close and students would have to travel to Cynffig Comprehensive. *An alternative would be that all three schools merge their sixth forms.*

Outcome E – Maesteg School hosts a sixth form-centre and hosts sixth-form students from Coleg Cymunedol y Dderwen

Because of the distance students would have to travel to another school or sixth-form centre it is proposed that Maesteg School would be developed into a sixth-form centre. If the centre was developed then the sixth form at Coleg Cymunedol y Dderwen (CCYD) would close and students would attend Maesteg School. *An alternative would be that the two schools merge their sixth forms*.

Outcome F – Maesteg School and Pencoed Comprehensive both become sixth-form centres and host sixth-form students from Cynffig Comprehensive and Coleg Cymunedol y Dderwen

Maesteg School and Pencoed Comprehensive both become sixth-form centres and host students from Cynffig Comprehensive School and Coleg Cymunedol y Dderwen.

Students would also have the opportunity to attend a sixth-form centre at Pencoed Comprehensive School. However, Pencoed Comprehensive School is expected to have a demand for places that exceeds its capacity.

Option 2

Outcome A – Sixth-form centre in Bridgend town run by the college for students from Cynffig Comprehensive School, Coleg Cymunedol y Dderwen and Pencoed Comprehensive School and Bryntirion Comprehensive School (if Bryntirion does not merge with Brynteg).

Part of the town centre in Bridgend would be redeveloped to provide a new campus for Bridgend College which would include a new sixth-form centre.

Bridgend College is more likely to develop sixth-form centres that can support more learners.

This centre would be expected to draw sixth-form students from Cynffig Comprehensive School, Coleg Cymunedol y Dderwen and Pencoed Comprehensive School and Bryntirion Comprehensive School (if Bryntirion does not merge with Brynteg).

There may be an issue with competition and duplication of courses with the sixth form at Brynteg School.

Outcome B – Sixth-form centre at Bridgend College's Pencoed	

Outcome B – Sixth-form centre at Bridgend College's Pencoed Campus run by the college and hosting sixth-form students from Pencoed Comprehensive, Cynffig Comprehensive School and Coleg Cymunedol y Dderwen.

Bridgend College has plans to build a new centre at its Pencoed campus for Science, Technology, Engineering and Arts and Media.

The design of the centre will also allow for its future expansion to incorporate a sixth-form centre.

Pencoed Comprehensive already works in partnership with the college.

This proposal would mean sixth-form pupils at Pencoed Comprehensive completely transferring to the college.

Pencoed Comprehensive School could become an 11-16 school or merge its sixth form with the college.

It is expected that this FE sixth-form centre would also attract students from Cynffig Comprehensive School and Coleg Cymunedol y Dderwen.
