DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER NO.1 2024

The above Order made on the 28/02/2024, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by adding to them the Restricted Byway from the junction with Footpath 8 Cefn Cribwr at Point A (Grid Reference SS 85458209), and proceeding in a general north north-easterly direction for approximately 185 metres to its junction with the current maintainable highway at Ty Isaf Road, at Point B (Grid Reference SS 85518226).

If no representations or objections are duly made to the order (or to any part of it), or if any so made are withdrawn, the Bridgend County Borough Council, instead of submitting the order to the Welsh Ministers (or part of it if the authority has by notice to the Welsh Ministers so elected under paragraph 5 of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981) may itself confirm the order (or that part of the order). If the order is submitted to the Welsh Ministers (in whole or in part), any representations or objections which have not withdrawn will be sent with it.
