

BRIDGEND COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL (TEMPORARY FOOTPATH CLOSURE) (FOOTPATH 16 LLANGYNWYD LOWER) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council as the Highway Authority for Llangynwyd Lower in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) intends in not less than 7 days from the date of this Notice to make an Order which will temporarily close the footpaths set out in the schedule below. The Order is necessary in the interest of public safety as a result of a recent inspection of the footpath where it was noted that there was extensive damage to the steps on that section of Footpath 16 Llangynwyd Lower, as such it is unsafe for the public to use. It will not be possible to implement the required repairs during the period of an emergency closure and as such, a further temporary closure is required to implement the necessary works.

Schedule

Footpath 16 Llangynwyd Lower from its junction with the A4063 a point approximately 83 meters south of property known as 1 Box Cottages in a general north easterly and northerly direction for approximately 112 meters to the southeastern corner of the property known as 1 Riverside Cottages.

The Order will come into force on the 22/05/2025 and will continue in force for a maximum period of six months or until the works are completed whichever is the sooner.

The restriction shall however only apply at such time and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.

The alternative route if travelling in a northerly direction is via the footway adjacent to the A4063 in a general north north-westerly and north north-easterly direction for approximately 220 meters to its junction with Footpath 16 Llangynwyd Lower and Vice Versa.
