

BRIDGEND COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL
(A4063 COYTRAHEN) (A4063 LLANGYNWYDD)(30MPH SPEED LIMIT)
(50MPH SPEED LIMIT) TRAFFIC ORDER 2022

THE BRIDGEND COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL (“the Council”) as the Highway Authority for Coytrahen and Llangynwydd, in exercise of their powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and in consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into force on the 9th day of March 2022 and may be cited as the “BRIDGEND COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL (A4063 COYTRAHEN) (A4063 LLANGYNWYDD)(30MPH SPEED LIMIT)(50MPH SPEED LIMIT) TRAFFIC ORDER 2022”.
2. No person shall cause any vehicle to be driven at a speed in excess of 30 miles per hour on the lengths of roads and sides of lengths of roads contained in Schedule 1 of this Order.
3. No person shall cause any vehicle to be driven at a speed in excess of 50 miles per hour on the lengths of roads and sides of lengths of roads contained in Schedule 2 of this Order.
4. The prohibition introduced by this Order does not apply to an exempted vehicle.
5. In this Order “exempted vehicle” means:
 - (a) any vehicle being used by the emergency services for the purposes described in section 87 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
 - (b) any vehicle being used for naval, military or air force purposes, and being driven by a person for the time being subject to the orders of the member of the armed forces of the Crown, who is a member of the special forces-
 - (i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving at high speeds: or
 - (ii) for the purposes of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds.

“special forces” means those units of the armed forces the maintenance of whose capabilities is the responsibility of the Director of Special Forces or which are for the time being subject to the operational command of that Director.
6. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with a provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act existing at the time when this Order comes into operation and which imposes a restriction or prohibition on vehicles in the lengths of roads contained in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

7. The prohibition or requirement imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

SCHEDULE 1 (30MPH SPEED LIMIT)

- (i) **A4063 Coytrahen** - From a point 35 meters (38 yards) north of the centreline point of the A4063's junction with Shwt Bridge, southwards for a distance of approximately 360 meters (394 yards).
- (ii) **A4063 Llangynwyd** - From a point 60 meters (60 yards) south of the centreline point of the junction entrance to Ysgol Gyfun Gyrmraeg Llangynwyd, southwards for a distance of approximately 110 meters (120 yards).
- (iii) **A4063** - From a point 450 meters (492 yards) south east of the centreline point of its junction with the western entrance to WEPA for a distance of approximately 600 meters (656 yards).

SCHEDULE 2 (50MPH SPEED LIMIT)

- (i) **A4063 Llangynwyd** - From a point 170 meters (186 yards) south of the centreline point of the junction entrance to Ysgol Gyfun Gyrmraeg Llangynwyd, southwards for a distance of approximately 1520 meters (1662 yards).
- (ii) **A4063 Coytrahen** - From a point 35 meters (38 yards) north of the centreline point of the A4063's junction with Shwt Bridge, Northwards for a distance of approximately 780 meters (853 yards).
