Dear Keith,

Further to our conversation, the Inspector has asked me to contact you regarding the separate retailing session to be held on 6th December 2012.

As you are aware you are unable to appear at the hearings for Representor ID 142 as the representations support the allocation of the HQ site for housing as COM1(5). However it is not clear what South Police's position is as landowners in relation to Mango/Waterstone proposals and they may also be informally supporting those alternative sites.

The Inspector has programmed a separate Hearing session to deal with the above matter (Session 8 – Bridgend Convenience Retailing) and I have attached a copy of the agenda for your information.

I would be grateful if you could clarify SWP position as to whether they are now supporting residential or retail development at that site.

I would be grateful if you could advise whether SWP wish to appear to pursue Alt Site 056 proposals to extend the residential allocation having regard to the Council's response in Submission Document SD09?

If you do wish to appear that matter could be added to Session 8. If not it could be converted to written reps or deferred to a later session
