'The Breakfast Run' operates between 6:30am – 9am, 365 days a year. Staff support clients by providing humanitarian aid in the form of breakfast, hot drinks, sleeping bags, warm clothing, toiletries and linking in with further local provision.

The drop-in centre (10 Park Street, Bridgend, CF31 4AX) provides a safe environment off the street to facilitate support work. There are washing facilities and also access to a telephone and computer. Service users can access the rough sleeper drop in between 9:30am – 12noon Monday to Friday.

Afternoon drop-in available at 'The Zone' 46-48 Dunraven Place, Bridgend, CF31 1JB between 12 November 2018 – 31 March 2019, Monday – Friday 1:30pm – 4:30pm and Saturday 9am – 12noon.

Homeless service users will be offered hot food and drink in a warm and friendly environment.

Please note the afternoon drop in will not be available on 1 December and 24 December – 1 January. On these days provision will be available via Gwalia Hub and Floor Space.

Direct access provision providing a safe, dry and warm environment to sleep. Provision is available from 8pm – 8am, 365 days a year. The service will extend opening hours on Bank Holidays and in times of need, such as extreme weather.

Nine units with capacity to increase during times of need, e.g. extreme weather. Separate rooms for men and women.

Space is allocated on a night by night basis. To access provision, service users must present to the Gwalia Local Support Hub (Unit 2, Brackla Street Centre, Bridgend, CF31 1DD) between 3pm – 5pm. Actual provision provided at The Elms, Bridgend Industrial Estate, CF31 3SY.

Attached to the service is an engagement officer, providing intense, practical support to those who access Floor Space.
