NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council as the Highway Authority for Bridgend in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) intends in not less than 7 days from the date of this Notice to make an Order which will temporarily introduce the restriction set out in the schedule below.

The Order is necessary due to the Health and Safety of those attending and working the event, and the residents in the surrounding area.

The Order will come into force on the 12/07/2025 and will continue in force for a maximum period of 18 months or until such time as the event is completed, whichever is the sooner.

It is anticipated that the restriction will be operative from 08:00am on 12/07/2025 to 17:00pm on 13/07/2025.

Schedule

A one-way system is to be implemented on Merthyr Mawr Road - from its junction with New Inn Road, to its junction with A48.

The alternative route for vehicles is Via the A48, Ewenny Road, and New Inn Road.

Access will be maintained for emergency services through diversion. Pedestrian access will be maintained to all properties.

The restrictions shall however only apply at such time and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
