Schedule

A 188-metre section of Footpath 12 Coychurch Lower from its junction with Meadow Close at Point A and proceeding in a north-easterly, then north-westerly following the embankment before turning north and crossing the railway to Point B.

The Order will come into force on the 21/06/2025 and will continue in force for a maximum period of six months or until the works are completed whichever is the sooner.

The restriction shall however only apply at such time and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
