

Age Policy Guidelines

- Vehicles submitted for licensing for the first time must be less than 5 years old from the date of first registration.
- The only exception to the above is that Minibus type vehicles fitted with permanent automated tail lifts submitted for licensing for the first time must be less than 10 years old from the date of first registration.
- Vehicles aged up to 10 years old at the time of application will be tested twice a year.
- Vehicles aged over 10 years old at the time of application will be tested three times per year
- Vehicle testing must be an MOT Certificate and Declaration of Fitness Certificate (the additional taxi/private hire test) from any DVSA approved MOT testing station within the Bridgend County Borough administrative area. These certificates may be obtained up to 1 month prior to the requirement for testing.
- Hackney Carriage vehicles will require a Meter Calibration Certificate upon grant or renewal of a licence. This must be dated within 1 month of submitting the application.
- The MOT Certificate, Declaration of Fitness Certificate and Meter Calibration Certificate (if applicable) must be obtained prior to submitting an application.
- If an applicant fails to submit an application to renew a vehicle licence in time, provided a completed application is received within five days of the expiry date the requirement for a vehicle to be presented to Committee is waived.
- Applications for converted or modified vehicles outside the M1 Vehicle Type approval category must be accompanied by a full-service history and appropriate safety certification including a Voluntary Individual Vehicle Approval (IVA) Certificate issued by the Driving and Vehicle Standards Agency (DVSA).

- Rhaid i gerbydau a gyflwynir i'w trwyddedu am y tro cyntaf fod yn llai na 5 mlwydd oed o ddyddiad y cofrestriad cyntaf.
- Yr unig eithriad i'r uchod yw bod yn rhaid i gerbydau o fath Bws Mini sydd â liffitiau codi awtomataidd parhaol a gyflwynir i'w trwyddedu am y tro cyntaf fod yn llai na 10 mlwydd oed o ddyddiad y cofrestriad cyntaf.
- Bydd cerbydau hyd at 10 oed ar adeg gwneud cais yn cael eu profi ddwywaith y flwyddyn.
- Bydd cerbydau dros 10 oed ar adeg gwneud cais yn cael eu profi deirgwaith y flwyddyn.
- Rhaid profi cerbydau a chael Tystysgrif MOT a Thystysgrif Datganiad Cymhwysedd (y prawf ychwanegol ar gyfer tacsis/cerbydau hurio preifat) o unrhyw garej profion MOT a gymeradwywyd gan y DVSA yn ardal weinyddol Bwrdeistref Sirol Pen-y-bont ar Ogwr. Gellir cael y tystysgrifau hyn hyd at 1 mis cyn y gofyniad am brawf.
- Bydd angen Tystysgrif Graddnodi Mesurydd ar Gerbydau Hacni wrth gael neu adnewyddu trwydded. Rhaid i hon fod wedi'i dyddio o fewn 1 mis o gyflwyno'r cais.
- Rhaid cael y Dystysgrif MOT, y Dystysgrif Datganiad Cymhwysedd a'r Dystysgrif Graddnodi Mesurydd (os yn berthnasol) cyn cyflwyno cais.
- Os yw ymgeisydd yn methu â chyflwyno cais am adnewyddu trwydded cerbyd mewn pryd, cyhyd â bod cais wedi'i gwblhau yn dod i law o fewn pum niwrnod i'r dyddiad dod i ben, caiff y gofyniad i gyflwyno cerbyd i'r Pwyllgor ei hepgor.
- Rhaid i geisiadau am gerbydau wedi'u haddasu y tu allan i gategori cymeradwyo Math o Gerbyd M1 gynnwys hanes gwasanaeth llawn ac ardystiad diogelwch priodol gan gynnwys Tystysgrif Cymeradwyo Cerbyd Unigol Gwirfoddol (IVA) a gyhoeddir gan yr Asiantaeth Safonau Gyrru a Cherbydau (DVSA).
