The above order was made on 10/09/2025. The effect of the Order will be to divert that section of Footpath 55 Coychurch Higher commencing at Point A (Grid Ref. SS 9362 8465) and proceeding in a general southerly direction for 185 metres to Point B (Grid Ref. SS 9365 8447), and continuing in a general southeasterly direction for 250 metres to Point C (Grid Ref. SS 9381 8429) where it joins Footpath 37 to a new section of footpath commencing at its junction with Footpath 37 at Point D (Grid Ref. SS 9395 8439) and proceeding west for 8 metres to Point E (Grid Ref. SS 9395 8440), then continuing in a general north northwesterly direction for 201 metres to Point F (Grid Ref. SS 9386 8458) before proceeding in a general northeasterly direction for 19 metres to Point G (Grid Ref. SS 9387 8459), then continuing in a general north north-westerly direction along a field boundary for 99 metres to Point H (Grid Ref. SS 9382 8467), then turning west and proceeding for 195 metres to Point I (Grid Ref. SS 9363 8463) then turning north northwest and proceeding for 22 metres to rejoin Footpath 55 at Point A (Grid Ref. SS 9362 8465) as shown on the order map.

The Footpath shall be subject to the limitation of a field gate to BS 5709:2018 at Point E (Grid Ref. SS 9395 8440), and two pedestrian gates to BS 5709:2018 at Point X1 (Grid Ref. SS 9364 8463) and Point X2 (Grid Ref. SS 9364 8463).
