

BRIDGEND COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL (TEMPORARY FOOTPATH CLOSURE) (FOOTPATH 6 BRACKLA, BRIDGEND) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council as the Highway Authority for Brackla in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) intends in not less than 7 days from the date of this Notice to make an Order which will temporarily close the footpaths set out in the schedule below. The Order is necessary in the interest of public safety due to the deterioration in the Footpath surface meaning that it is unsafe for the public to use. A temporary closure is needed to protect the public and to enable works to be undertaken to repair the surface.

Schedule

That section of Footpath 6 Brackla - commencing at the south-eastern corner of the property known as Number 29 Fenwick Drive, Brackla, and proceeding in a generally south south-easterly direction for 104 metres to the boardwalk / footbridge.

The Order will come into force on the 03/08/2025 to coincide with the expiry of the current emergency closure and will continue in force for a maximum period of six months or until the works are completed whichever is the sooner.

The restriction shall however only apply at such time and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.

There is no suitable alternative route available.
