

**BRIDGEND COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL**  
**(OFF- STREET PARKING PLACES)(CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2024**  
**(AMENDMENT NO. 1) ORDER 202—**

The Bridgend County Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”), intend to make an Order in exercise of their powers under Sections 32, 35 and Part IV of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act the effect of which will be to vary the Bridgend County Borough Council (Off- Street Parking Places)(Consolidation) Order 2024 (“the 2024 Order”) the effect of which will be to permanently close the Hillsboro Place South Car Park, Porthcawl.

The site of the car park has been earmarked as a site of public realm and therefore it is proposed to permanently close this car park to facilitate the implementation of the public realm area.
