## BRIDGEND COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL (BRIDGE STREET, MAESTEG) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDER 2025

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council as the Highway Authority for Maesteg in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) intends in not less than 7 days from the date of this Notice to make an Order which will temporarily introduce the restriction set out in the schedule below.

The Order is necessary to prevent access onto and to subsequently facilitate the resurfacing of Bethania Street, Maesteg.

The Order will come into force on the 05/08/2025 and will continue in force for a maximum period of 18 months or until such time as the works are completed, whichever is the sooner.

It is anticipated the planned works will be undertaken daily between the hours of 08:00am and 17:00pm from 05/08/2025 to 07/08/2025, or until such time as the works are completed up to a maximum of 18 months.

## Schedule

No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed along Bridge Street, Maesteg, from its junction with Bethania Street to its junction with Bank Street, a distance of approximately 50 meters.

The alternative route for vehicles is via, Bethania Street, Commercial Street, Talbot Street, Castle Street, and Bridge Street and vice versa.

Access will be provided through the restriction for emergency services. Pedestrian access will be maintained.

The restrictions shall however only apply at such time and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
