BRIDGEND COUNTY BOROUGH (VARIOUS ROADS) (RESTORATION OF 30 MPH SPEED LIMITS) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025

NOTICE

NOTICE is hereby given that Bridgend County Borough Council ("the Council") intends to make an Order in exercise of its powers under sections 82(2), 83 and 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) ("the Act").

The effect of the proposed Order is to increase the speed limits on three sections of road from 20-mph to 30-mph. This follows the Welsh Government's updated guidance and the Council's further consultation on, and reassessment of, the setting of exceptions to the setting of a speed limit on restricted roads in Wales to 20-mph. The locations at which it is proposed to reintroduce a 30-mph speed limit are set out in Schedule 1 below.
