

BRIDGEND COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2024 (AMENDMENT NO.4) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Bridgend County Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) as the Highway Authority for Bridgend, have made the following Order in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (2), 4,124(1) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police and in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 the effect of which will be to amend the following restrictions in the BRIDGEND COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2024 (“**the Consolidation Order**”), as amended, by the insertion of the Order Plan **AG59**, the effect of which will be as set out in the Schedule below.

The order was made on the 12/03/2026 and will come into force on the **26/03/2026**. If any person wishes to question the validity of any Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court. SCHEDULE

1.INTRODUCTION OF A PROHIBITION OF WAITING LOADING AND UNLOADING AT ANY TIME RESTRICTION

Wyndham Close, Brackla Industrial Estate, Bridgend

- (i) On its northern side from a point 55 metres (60 yards) east of a point opposite the south eastern side of its junction with Heol Ffaldau, westwards and then north for a distance of 114 metres (125 yards).
- (ii) On its southern side, from its junction with the north western side of Heol Ffaldau, in a north westerly direction, for a distance of approximately 38 meters (42 yards).
- (iii) On its southern side, from its junction with the south eastern side of Heol Ffaldau, in a easterly direction, for a distance of approximately 57 meters (62 yards).

Heol Ffaldau, Brackla Industrial Estate, Bridgend

- (i) On its north western side, from its junction with Wyndham Close, in a south westerly direction, for a distance of approximately 40 meters (44 yards).
- (ii) On its south western side, from its junction with Wyndham Close, in a south westerly direction, for a distance of approximately 43 meters (47 yards).
