ADDITION OF FOOTPATH LEADING FROM ADJACENT TO GAMEKEEPER'S LODGE, PEN-
Y-FAI, TO FOOTPATH 5 NEWCASTLE HIGHER
DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER NO.1 2026

The above Order made on the 11/02/2026, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by adding to them the footpath commences at Point A (Grid Reference SS 89128176) at the Kissing Gate 38 metres south south west of the southeast corner of the property known as Gamekeepers Cottage and proceeding in a west, north westerly direction for approximately 15 metres to Point B (Grid Reference SS 89118176) where it turns and runs in a northerly direction adjacent to Gamekeeper's Lodge for approximately 73 metres to Point C (Grid Reference SS 89118184). The route then crosses the former access track to Court Colman in a north north westerly then north north easterly direction for approximately 9 metres to the Kissing gate at Point D (Grid Reference SS 89118150) and continues in a north easterly direction for a further 161 metres approximately to the gate at Point E (Grid Reference SS 89188199) terminating at its junction with Footpath 5 Newcastle Higher. There are kissing gates at Grid References SS 89128176 and SS 89118150 and a field gate at Grid Reference SS 89188199.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the order (or to any part of it), or if any so made are withdrawn, the Bridgend County Borough Council, instead of submitting the order to the Welsh Ministers (or part of it if the authority has by notice to the Welsh Ministers so elected under paragraph 5 of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981) may itself confirm the order (or that part of the order). If the order is submitted to the Welsh Ministers (in whole or in part), any representations or objections which have not withdrawn will be sent with it.
