In light of the cancellation of Hearing Session 4 - Productive and Enterprising Places – Employment and Infrastructure, I would be grateful if you could provide a written response to the following questions:

- 1. Policy ENT1 should reference to 'the Council' be deleted?
- 2. Policy ENT2- is the Council proposing to delete the former Christie Tyler site from the policy, and if so, why?
- 3. Policy ENT3 should the policy be amended to read 'will be supported where' rather than 'will also be permitted unless'?
- 4. Policy ENT4 should the policy be amended to read 'supported' rather than 'positive weight'?
- 5. Policy ENT5 should the policy be revised to omit the reference to 'the Council' and to provide criteria which would support / guide the future redevelopment of the site?
- 6. Policy COM9 should the policy be amended to read 'Where it can be demonstrated' rather than 'In the view of the LPA'?
- 7. Policy COM14 should the reasoned justification of the policy be amended to include reference to Future Wales and the importance of digital communication infrastructure? and
- 8. Policy SP10 should criteria 9 of the policy include reference to 'health facilities?

The Council should submit this further information and a list of proposed changes to the RLDP as soon as it is available, and no later than 24 March 2023.
