NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF RAIL CROSSING (DIVERSION) ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 SECTION 119A BRIDGEND COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL (DIVERSION OF FOOTPATH 16 COYCHURCH LOWER) RAIL CROSSING DIVERSION ORDER NO. 1 2025

On the 09/04/2025 the Bridgend County Borough Council confirmed the above Order, made under Section 119A of the Highways Act 1980 (as amended by the Transport and Works Act 1992). The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert that section of Footpath 16 Coychurch Lower, commencing at Point A (Grid Reference SS 9500 8035), south of the railway line, and proceeds in a general west-northwesterly direction through a field and a farmyard for approximately 158 metres to Torcoed Farm, Point B (Grid Reference SS 9484 8040) to a new section of footpath commencing at Point A (Grid Reference SS 9500 8035), south of the railway line, and proceeds in a general west-southwesterly direction for approximately 147 metres along a gravel surfaced path before passing through a field gate at Point C (Grid Reference SS 9487 8028) the route then continues in a west-southwesterly direction for approximately 7 metres to terminate at its junction with FP 15 Coychurch Lower at Point D (Grid Reference SS 9487 8027), as shown on the order map. The new public footpath will have a width of 1.8 metres.

The order comes into force as from 08/05/2025, but if any person aggrieved by the order desires to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980 as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act as amended, or of any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 17/04/2025, make an application to the High Court.
