PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER NO. 1 2025

The above order was made on 16/07/2025. The effect of the Order will be to divert that section of Public Footpath 17 Porthcawl from a point (Grid Ref. SS 84097743), and proceeding in a general easterly direction for approximately 52 metres to a point (Grid Ref. SS 84147743) the route then continues in a general north north-easterly direction for approximately 8 metres to a point (Grid Ref. SS 84147743) to a line running from a point (Grid Ref. SS 84097744) and proceeding in a general easterly direction for approximately 10 metres to a point (Grid Ref. SS 84107744) before continuing in an east south-easterly direction for approximately 8 metres to a point (Grid Ref. SS 84107743), the route then continues in a general easterly direction for approximately 34 metres to a point (Grid Ref. SS 84147743) before turning and running in a north-easterly direction for approximately 4 metres to a point (Grid Ref. SS 84147743), as shown on the order map.
