SECTION 53 OF THE WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 **THE BRIDGEND COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT** **BRIDGEND COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL** **ADDITION OF FOOTPATH FROM HARTSHORN TERRACE TO ATLEE TERRACE, CAERAU** **DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER NO.2 2026**

The above Order made on the 19/05/2026, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by adding to them the footpath from the junction of the maintainable highway at Hartshorn Terrace, Caerau, at Point A (Grid Reference SS 85499464) and proceeding in a general north north-easterly direction for approximately 95 metres then continuing in a west north-westerly direction for approximately 71 metres to its junction with the maintainable highway at Atlee Terrace, Caerau, Point B (Grid Reference SS 85449476).

Any representation or objection relating to the order must be sent in writing to K. If no representations or objections are duly made to the order (or to any part of it), or if any so made are withdrawn, the Bridgend County Borough Council, instead of submitting the order to the Welsh Ministers (or part of it if the authority has by notice to the Welsh Ministers so elected under paragraph 5 of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981) may itself confirm the order (or that part of the order). If the order is submitted to the Welsh Ministers (in whole or in part), any representations or objections which have not withdrawn will be sent with it.
